FRONT END LOADER DAILY CHECKLIST

Include any checks as per the operators' manual and NOHSC 7019 (1992)

- To be carried out at the start of each day. Checklist to be retained with vehicle.
- Any defects are to be listed on sheet and supervisor to be notified of defect.
- Supervisor to arrange repairs of defects. Place 'Out of Service' tag on equipment if required.
- Supervisor to ensure that repairs are signed off by repairer in 'Defects Log' when completed.
- For further information refer to manufacturer's or operator's manual.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Tyres – condition, inflation, wheel nut ➤ Leaks – hydraulic hoses, cylinders, check ground for oil or water leaks ➤ Damage/Wear/Security – hydraulic hoses, bucket /attachment, cutting edge, lights/fittings, ROPS guard, pivot points all greased, other obvious defects. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Clean and free of leaks ➤ Oils – engine, hydraulic, transmission if req'd ➤ Coolant ➤ Battery clean and secure ➤ Air cleaner / pre cleaner bowl 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Steps, pedals are clean ➤ Cabin floor clean ➤ Seat, seat belt ➤ Mirrors ➤ Warning devices – horn, rotating light, lights, alarms 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Running smoothly, gauges, fuel level ➤ Hydraulic operations ➤ Brakes – park and in service ➤ Steering
